

## NUMBER OF AP EXAMINATIONS PER STUDENT

The number of AP Examinations taken per student is presented below for 1993 and 2003. Note that in 2003 approximately 82% of the students took either one or two AP Examinations during the May administration. The remaining 18% took from three to thirteen exams.

Approximately 32% of the students took AP Examinations in more than one year. The figures below show the cumulative number of exams individual students took from the years 1990 to 1993 and from 2000 to 2003. Note, for example, that 88,486 students took three or more AP Exams in the years 1990 to 1993 and were therefore potentially eligible for sophomore standing; in 2003, 291,816 students had three or more AP Exams on their records. By 2003, 4,692 students had amassed 9 AP Exams, 2,370 had 10 exams, 1,145 had 11 exams, 598 had 12 exams, 304 students had 13 exams, 122 had 14 exams, 54 had 15 exams, 32 had 16 exams, 13 had 17 exams, 5 had 18 exams, 2 had 19 exams, 2 had 20 exams, and 1 had amassed 21 AP Exams.
